## **IMPORTANT NOTICES**

- DNA fingerprinting must be completed for any Standardbred Stallions that have not been previously registered as a Sire in Australia. The DNA fee of **\$65.50** should be forwarded with the Hair Sample in the appropriate sample collection kit to **Racing and Wagering Western Australia prior to any mares being served**. If you require a collection kit, please call the phone number on this form.
- Standardbred Stallions must be officially registered with RWWA prior to any services taking place. Any applications not lodged correctly completed with payment will be returned to the stallion owner. It is important this document be submitted correctly on or before 1<sup>st</sup> October 2012, in accordance with RWWA Rules of Harness Racing 274 (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6) & (7).
- Once the Stud and Standardbred Stallion(s) have been registered, a Certificate of Registration for the Stud and Standardbred Stallion(s) will be forwarded to the Studmaster. As with the 2011/2012 Standardbred Stud season, if a Studmaster enters their stallion services electronically on Harness Web the fee of \$40 per mare served will be waived. However, if the Studmaster requires RWWA to manually enter the service details, the fee will remain at \$40 per mare served if lodged correctly completed on or before **31 March 2012. The late lodgement fee for mare services will be \$100 per mare for both electronic and manual entry.** Certificates of Service will be generated by RWWA and sent to the Studmaster for signing and distributing to the mare owners once the Foaling Notification fee for the following season is finalised. It is the Studmaster's responsibility to issue the mare owners with the Certificates of Service.
- A reminder that all mares served, regardless of whether they are in foal or not, must be lodged on each individual stallion's services. Failure to do so is a breach of the RWWA Rules of Harness Racing and penalties may be incurred.
- Certificates will not be issued for negative pregnancy results. Any mares tested negative will automatically result in a 'Mare Missed' notation on RWWA's database.
- The Studmaster is responsible for the positive identification of the mare PRIOR to any service taking place. It is a breach of Rule 276 (1), (2), (3) & (4) to not ensure the identity of the mare prior to service.
- Artificial Insemination or Semen Transportation must not be practised on any premises in Western Australia until the premises has been granted a Licence for an Artificial Breeding Station with Racing and Wagering Western Australia. - Any person who wishes to perform Artificial Insemination on any registered Standardbred in Western Australia must be licensed with RWWA before they undertake any act of Artificial Insemination. Applications can be obtained from [www.rwwa.com.au](http://www.rwwa.com.au).
