Race 1 - Qualifying Trial/Provincial/380 - Qualifying Trial - 6:15 PM

(380M): MY NAN'S EPIC & PAD UP OPAL began quickly. BROWNIE'S GIRL & STELLA FOREVER collided soon after the start. BROWNIE'S GIRL, STELLA FOREVER & CASUAL MONKEY collided on the first turn. BROWNIE'S GIRL, STELLA FOREVER, CASUAL MONKEY & MIDNIGHT RAIDER collided on the first turn. MY NAN'S EPIC & PAD UP OPAL collided on the first turn. MY NAN'S EPIC galloped on the heels of PAD UP OPAL in the back straight. PAD UP OPAL eased, shifted out and collided several times with MY NAN'S EPIC in the back straight, both stumbled and lost considerable ground. CASUAL MONKEY & MIDNIGHT RAIDER collided in the back straight. PAD UP OPAL eased, shifted out and collided several times with MY NAN'S EPIC on the second turn, both stumbled and lost ground.

PAD UP OPAL was examined by the course Veterinary Surgeon and no apparent injury was reported.

Stewards inquired into a report that PAD UP OPAL had failed to pursue the lure with due commitment in the back straight and on the second turn. Trainer Mr P Brown acknowledged the report, subsequently PAD UP OPAL has been stood down for 28 days (Cannington Track) and placed on a Field Satisfactory Trial under R124.

Race 2 - Qualifying Trial/City/520 - Qualifying Trial - 6:25 PM

(520M): BELL MAC BLAZER began quickly. GALLIUM stumbled and lost ground on the second turn. GALLIUM eased and lost ground on the second turn. ALL THE TALK checked off the heels of GALLIUM approaching the third turn. ALL THE TALK veered in and marred GALLIUM in the home straight.

GALLIUM was examined by the course Veterinary Surgeon and no apparent injury was reported.

Stewards inquired into a report that GALLIUM had failed to pursue the lure with due commitment on the second turn. Kennel Representative Ms K Erenshaw acknowledged the report, subsequently GALLIUM has been stood down for 28 days (Cannington Track) and placed on a Field Satisfactory Trial under R124.

Stewards inquired into a report that ALL THE TALK had marred in the home straight. Trainer Mr C White acknowledged the report, subsequently ALL THE TALK has been suspended for 28 days (Cannington Track) and placed on a Field Satisfactory Trial under R123.
