CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The series is for the best greyhounds, whelped on or after 1 January 2022.
Greyhounds will be selected for this event based on their City Sprint Grade using the City Class Graded Events Order of Choice.
Provincial Sprint Grade 5 eligible greyhounds with City Class form in their last three starts will continue to be selected using the City Class Graded Events Order of Choice. These greyhounds may include last start City Class Maiden winners and winners of a City Class Maiden in their last three starts.
Provincial Sprint Grade 5 eligible greyhounds without City Class form in their last three starts will be considered next; this process to be completed by a Grading Panel. Provincial and Country Class Maiden winners in their last three starts will be considered along with these greyhounds. As with the other feature events selected by a Grading Panel, the selection process is entirely at their discretion and no correspondence will be entered into.
Maiden greyhounds will remain eligible for the series and will be selected after all graded greyhounds. Maiden greyhounds should they be qualified over 520 metres at Cannington will be selected using the modified City Class Maiden Event Order of Choice as detailed below. This Order of Choice rewards Maiden greyhounds that have run a place in their last three starts.
 - Last start placegetter (City, then Provincial, then Country Class)
 - Placegetter 2 of last 3 starts (City, then Provincial, then Country Class)
 - Placegetter 1 of only 2 starts (City, then Provincial, then Country Class)
 - Placegetter 1 of last 3 starts (City, then Provincial, then Country Class)
 - Greyhounds having their first ever start, based on time run to qualify for Cannington
 - Greyhounds with only 1 start
 - Greyhounds with only 2 starts
 - Greyhounds having their first start after re-qualifying for Cannington, based on time run to re-qualify
 - Unplaced runners based on the Unplaced Runners Table
2. The onus is entirely upon the nominator to be aware of the conditions of entry that apply to this feature event and the lodgement of a nomination, by any method approved by RWWA, indicates full acceptance of the conditions of entry.
3. The field for the final will be selected using the RWWA Policy on Field Selection for Finals (as published).
4. Scratchings in this series will be dealt with in the following manner:
Heats – the reserve greyhound gaining a start will be by random ballot
Final – the 1st Reserve (No. 9) will take precedence over the 2nd Reserve (No. 10).
5. In the event of a "No Race" being declared, RWWA reserves the right to reschedule race(s) within the series to a date to be determined and the original draw will stand, with reserves reinstated. Alternatively a ballot may be conducted [refer Rule R57].
6. The prizes offered will be awarded subject to the statements herein contained being strictly accurate.
7. The owner or the registered lessee and trainer of the greyhound nominated for this feature event must be holders of current Registration Certificates issued by the Authority or an approved registration authority controlling body as defined in the RWWA Rules of Greyhound Racing.
8. The nominator hereby certifies that they are a registered person with the Authority, or an approved registration authority as defined in the RWWA Rules of Greyhound Racing. Furthermore the nominator certifies that they are the registered owner or trainer of this greyhound, or person authorised by the Stewards to nominate this greyhound, and assume full responsibility for the correctness of the particulars in this nomination.
9. RWWA reserves the right to add, delete or amend any of the conditions of the series should it be necessary to do so notwithstanding the conditions herein contained.
