(520M): HELLO I'M KEV began quickly. MOCHA BEAN & TRIFIVE collided soon after the start. HELLO I'M KEV & MOCHA BEAN collided on the first turn. HELLO I'M KEV checked off the heels of MOCHA BEAN on the first turn. MOCHA BEAN eased due to injury, veered out and collided heavily with HELLO I'M KEV on the first turn, HELLO I'M KEV stumbled and lost considerable ground. MOCHA BEAN inconvenienced RED RIGHT HAND on the first turn.

A post race veterinary examination revealed that HELLO I'M KEV had a left hindleg gracilis injury and has been stood down for 10 days.

A post race veterinary examination revealed that MOCHA BEAN had a right hindleg sartorius injury and has been stood down for 10 days.

Stewards inquired into a report that MOCHA BEAN had failed to pursue the lure with due commitment on the first turn, Trainer Mr Paul Stuart acknowledged the report, subsequently following the report of an injury of a right hindleg sartorius injury and a 10 days stand down period, MOCHA BEAN was placed on a field satisfactory trial in accordance with R69B.
