(302M): STEALTHY MOVER began quickly. CROCODILE FLASH checked off the heels of DANDALUP ROSE soon after the start.

Race 2 - Qualifying Trial/Provincial/405 (1) - Qualifying Trial - 5:18 PM

(405M): DIAMOND RITA began quickly. SMART BOOTS began slowly. TOKYO LI hit the inside running rail and lost ground on the first turn. WEST ON HONEY & SIGNS OF THE TIME collided approaching the home turn.

Race 3 - Qualifying Trial/Provincial/405 (2) - Qualifying Trial - 5:26 PM

(405M): HELLO I'M LOIS & NINJA MITTENS began quickly. JUST HER BEST & NOTHING TO FEAR began slowly. NOTHING TO FEAR & CHAROS MOSCOW collided soon after the start. HELLO I'M LOIS & WEST ON HAZEL collided approaching the first turn.

A post race veterinary examination revealed that NOTHING TO FEAR had a left and right foreleg extensor muscle injury and has been stood down for 14 days.

(405M): JUST A DREAMER & JUST A MYSTERY began quickly. JUST A BATTLER began slowly. WEST ON JASMINE & DANDALUP TOES collided soon after the start and approaching the first turn. JUST A DREAMER & JUST A MYSTERY collided on the first turn, JUST A MYSTERY lost ground. DANDALUP TOES & JUST A MYSTERY collided on the first turn. WEST ON JASMINE & DANDALUP TOES collided approaching the home turn. WEST ON JASMINE raced wide on the home turn. JUST A DREAMER raced ungenerously in the home straight and connections were warned.
