Who can enter

 - a. The prizes will be in the form of Vouchers and the Vouchers can only be used at the 2021 Perth APG Yearling Sale towards the purchase of a Westbred Racehorse or share in a Westbred Racehorse where such horse is sold via auction at the yearling sale.
 - i. 1st prize \$5,000 voucher
 - ii. 2nd prize \$5,000 voucher
 - b. The prizes must be used on a Westbred yearling that is purchased at the 2021 APG Perth Yearling Sale.
14. The entrant must be present at the APG Perth Yearling Sale on Sunday 28 February 2021, to be eligible to redeem the voucher. *Subject to Covid-19 restrictions.

RWWA does not provide any warranty or accept any liability in relation to the quality or performance of the Racehorses purchased, the number of races the Racehorses will compete in, the value of prize-winnings the Racehorses will win or the value of any prize. Any decision regarding the health of the Racehorses or the entry of the Racehorses into any race will be at the absolute discretion of the trainer of the Racehorse or the relevant racing authority.
