

GREYHOUND RECOVERY INITIATIVE

Races and Official Trials

- OTV advises person responsible of exam results and directs person responsible regarding further assessment.
- OTV completes Form A (Part A) and provides the original to person responsible.
- OTVA provides a copy of Form A (Part A) to the Stewards to be lodged with head office.
- OTVA contacts GRI-contracted vet clinic to arrange admission and transports greyhound to clinic, or person responsible transports the greyhound to the clinic of their choice (which may be GRI-contracted vet clinic).
- Off-course vet discusses all clinical decisions with the person responsible.
- Off course vet completes Form A (Part B) and returns the original to the person responsible.

- If treated by GRI-contracted vet clinic, vet clinic lodges the form directly with RWWA.
- If treated by an alternative vet clinic, person responsible lodges form (with invoices and payment receipt) via email to animalwelfare@rwwa.com.au within 28 days post-discharge.

- Person responsible arranges appropriate rehabilitation for the greyhound as per aftercare instructions from off-course vet.
- Person responsible completes Form C with treating veterinary surgeon and sends it to animalwelfare@rwwa.com.au at the end of the prescribed rehabilitation period.
- Person responsible remains responsible for rehoming the greyhound if not kept as a pet or for breeding purposes.
- Eligibility for admission to GAP will be as per the requirements of GAP's current intake procedures.
